In terms of the above decision taken by CCI Board, Memorandum of Understanding signed by your representative is enclosed for your kind reference.

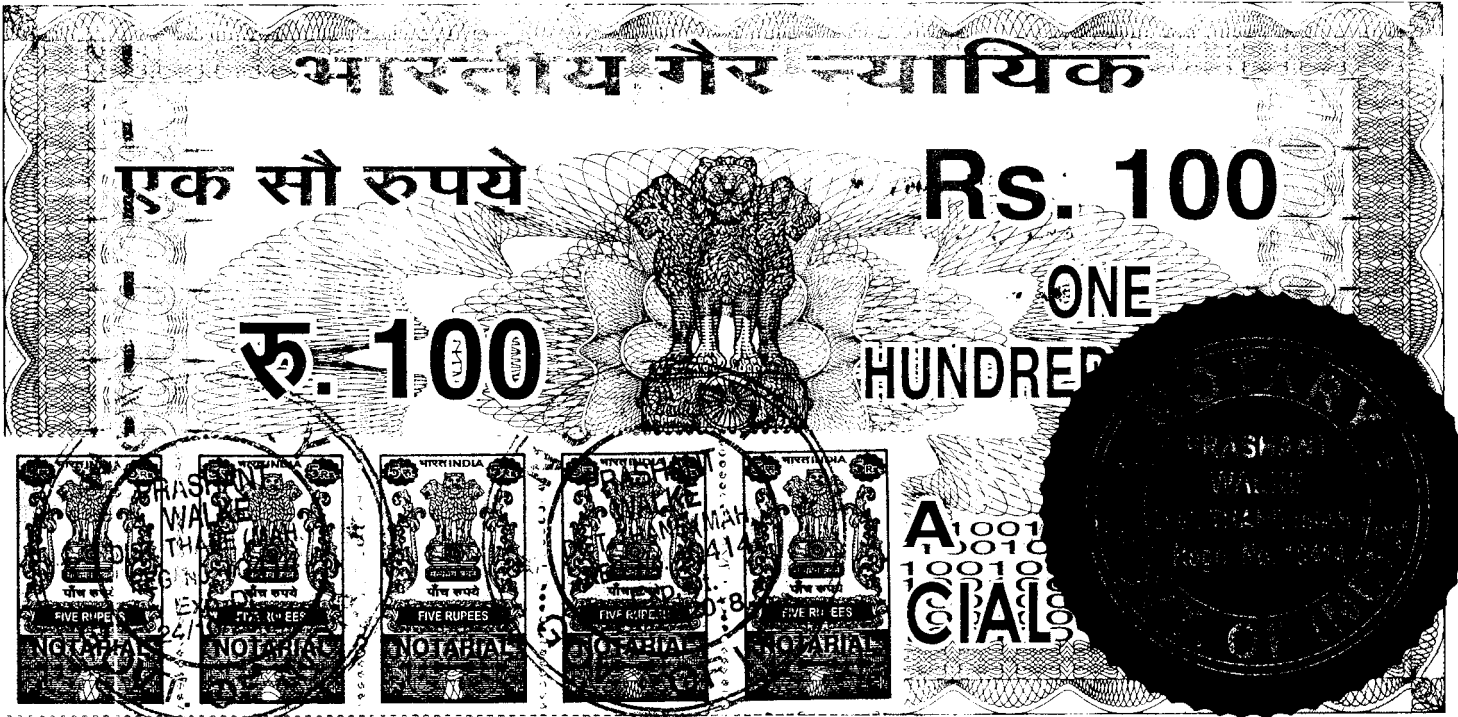

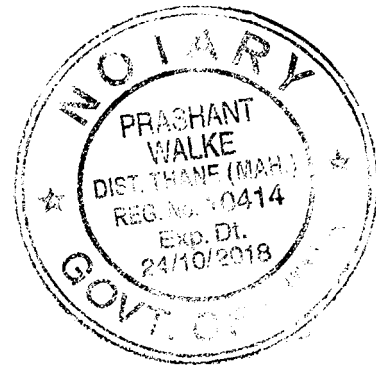
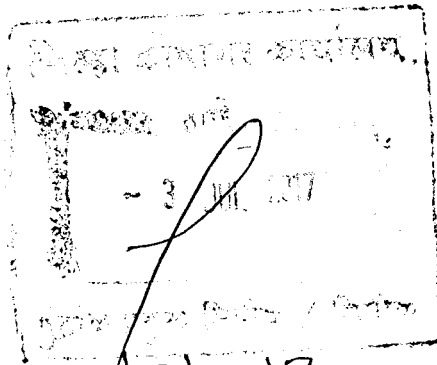

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

This Memorandum of understanding made on this 14<sup>th</sup> day of July 2017 between **THE COTTON CORPORATION OF INDIA LIMITED**, a Company incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956 & 2013 and having its Registered Office at Kapas Bhavan, Plot No.3A, Sector-10, CBD, Belapur, Navi Mumbai-400614, (hereinafter referred as "**CORPORATION**" or "**CCI**") of the ONE PART represented by through its authorized Signatory Shri M. M. Chockalingam

**BETWEEN**

**RETIRED EMPLOYEES** who retired after 01.04.2012 from the Corporation who have not received their own direct & indirect contribution (hereinafter referred as "**EX-EMPLOYEES**") of the **OTHER PARTY**.

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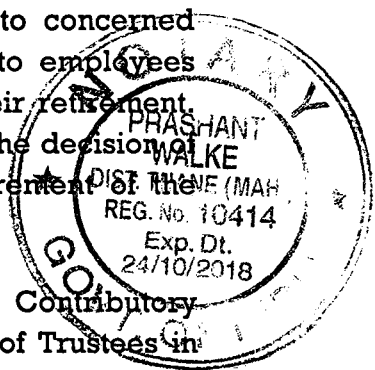
**BACKGROUND OF THE MATTER**

The Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) has introduced a welfare scheme called The Cotton Corporation of India Ltd. Employees' Contributory Superannuation Scheme (CCI-CSS) with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> November 1995 in accordance with an MOU between CCI and all India CCI Employees' Council for providing pension benefit to its employees in accordance with the rules in force from time to time The Management of the said Pension Scheme is vested with the Trustees (CCI CSS Trust) of the fund. The scheme was self financing scheme, wherein, all employees as on pay roll of Corporation on 1<sup>st</sup> November 1995 along with other employees joining thereafter were the members of CCICSS.

Being self financing the scheme was based on voluntary contribution by employees. However, a token contribution Rs.100/- p.a. was contributed by CCI as employer. The employees were accordingly contributing a fixed direct contribution of 2% to 5% per month of salary (BP + DA) depending on individual age on their entry. This contribution is deducted from monthly salary and transferred to Trust Corpus. Further, apart from direct contribution from employees, CCI were contributing variable component on employees' behalf by way of surrender of their six days EL, restricting their medical reimbursement, restricting their LTC. Monetary value of the savings in perquisites as above was paid by CCI to Trust depending on number of employees. Some modifications were made in the scheme by the trust from time to time.

The affairs of the trust is managed by Board of Trustees which comprises of equal number of Management representatives which include the Chairman cum Managing Director of the Corporation as Chairman of the Board of Trustees and nominated Employees' Council representatives which are managing the Trust Fund and responsible for functioning of the trust.

The benefit payable to the employee was by way of monthly pension against 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of annuity amount payable to LIC (which disburses monthly pension to concerned employee) and 1/3<sup>rd</sup> commutation (which is optional) to be paid to employees concerned as lump sum directly to as a members of the Trust on their retirement. Settlements of Pensionary benefits to the members were done as per the decision of the Board of Trustees as per the rules in force at the time of retirement of employees.



Due to ever increasing deficit in the corpus of the Employees Contributory Superannuation scheme, a Committee was constituted by the Board of Trustees in their meeting held on 03.04.2012 to suggest measures to strengthen financial position of the Trust after studying current level of contribution, outgo from the fund in the form of annuities, report of Actuary etc. The Committee was also advised to examine the status of the current scheme in the light of the O.M. No. 2(70)/08-DPE (WC)-GL-VII/09 dated 02.04.2009 issued by the DPE in connection with the implementation of the Pension scheme in the Central Public Sector Undertakings (CPSEs). The Board of Trustees along with invitee officials (also attended as one of the invitee) discussed at length and were of the view that the existing scheme is not viable in future unless corrective actions are taken at this juncture. Finally, Board of Trustees along with the invitees unanimously taken the decision of converting the CCIL Superannuation Scheme from Defined Benefit Scheme to Contribution Defined Scheme w.e.f from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2012 and the employees retiring from the services of the Corporation on 30.04.2012 and thereafter would get the annuity based on Defined Contribution Scheme. various facts, reports of the Actuary and DPE guidelines, the Committee presented its report before the Board of Trustees' in the meeting held on

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23/24.04.2012 The decision taken in the meeting of the Employees Contributory Superannuation Fund held on 23<sup>rd</sup> / 24<sup>th</sup> April 2012 was the unanimous decision by all the Trustees and officials present in the meeting in the larger interest of all the members, taking into consideration the financial position of the Trust and in order to stop depletion of funds and also to ensure perpetuity of the scheme. Accordingly, the above position was communicated to Ministry of Textiles (administrative Ministry of the Cotton Corporation of India) on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2012.

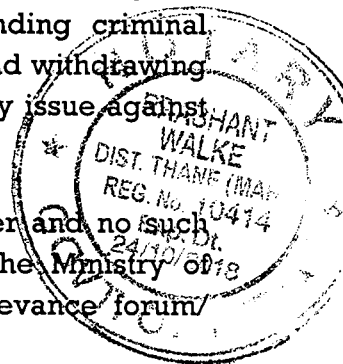
In as much as the difference in pension to the retired employees who retired after 01.04.2012 was very high there have been agitation from these employees and complaints have been made to the Ministry of Textiles, the Prime Minister's Office etc. Besides that, one of the retired employees have lodged criminal complaint with the police authorities stating that the pension funds have been misutilized and FIR No. CR No.40/13 dt. 08/03/2013 have been registered.

The Corporation has made all out effort to settle the grievances by taking up this matter with various forums and ultimately in the Board of Directors meeting held on 27.03.2017 after detailed deliberation resolved that :

In order to solve the grievances of the retired ex-employees and those employees on roll as on 01.04.2012 who have not received their own direct & indirect contribution with interest, a net shortfall was arrived after adjustment of employer contribution made subsequently after 01.04.2012 onwards (which is as per DPE O.M dated 02.04.2009) to the shortfall as on 01.04.2012 alongwith interest @ 5% upto 31/03/2017, it was decided by the Board that Rs.6.00 Crore as a one-time measure may be granted by the Company out-of company's own reserve & surplus, subject to the conditions that the retired employees should sign an MOU with CCI for one time full & final settlement and they should withdraw FIR lodged/complaints, all the grievances and pending cases filed by them and shall not raise this issue in future again.














In as much as the long pending grievance is now settled by the Management, "the retired employees" in turn agree;

- i) To withdraw the FIR No. CR No.40/13 dt. 08/03/2013 registered with the police authorities/high court and Mr.Rajendra M Deshmukh and others being the complainants shall file and tender consent affidavit in pending criminal application no. APL453/2013 giving his consent for quashing and withdrawing of the pending FIR and in future Management will not raise any issue against any retired employees under this MOU.
- ii) That there will not be any further representation in this matter and no such grievance/ complaints etc will be raised or addressed to the Ministry of Textiles or Hon'ble Prime Minister's Office or any other grievance forum/ authority/ court.
- iii) The settlement made is full and final and no further representation in the matter regarding enhanced pension will be considered by the Management and that the retired employees also agree not to raise such issues in future.




